



Pickleball Ball Machine Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost?

The cost is \$5 per one hour or \$30 per year per individual.

Is the fee renewed annually?

The fee can be renewed on a rolling calendar. If you signed up on 2/1/22, you can renew on 2/1/23.

Who can sign up to use the ball machine?

The ball machine can be used by KKPOA residents (IPO), Amenity Lot Owners (ALO) and Unimproved Lot Owners (UPO). In the case of UPOs, an additional \$10 daily court usage fee is required.

Once I pay for the ball machine, how do get a key to the storage locker on Court 3?

The Welcome Desk staff at the FRC will gladly hold on to your car keys in exchange for the storage key to the Ball Machine Storage locker. The storage key also has the key fob to operate the ball machine remotely. After securing the ball machine in its storage shed, return the storage locker key to the Front Staff and you will receive your car keys.

Which court should be reserved for the ball machine?

Ideally, court 3 should be reserved to use the ball machine. The divider nets can be drawn to keep most balls on your court.

If I've paid for the ball machine, can I invite non-paying members to drill, pick up balls?

Yes.
