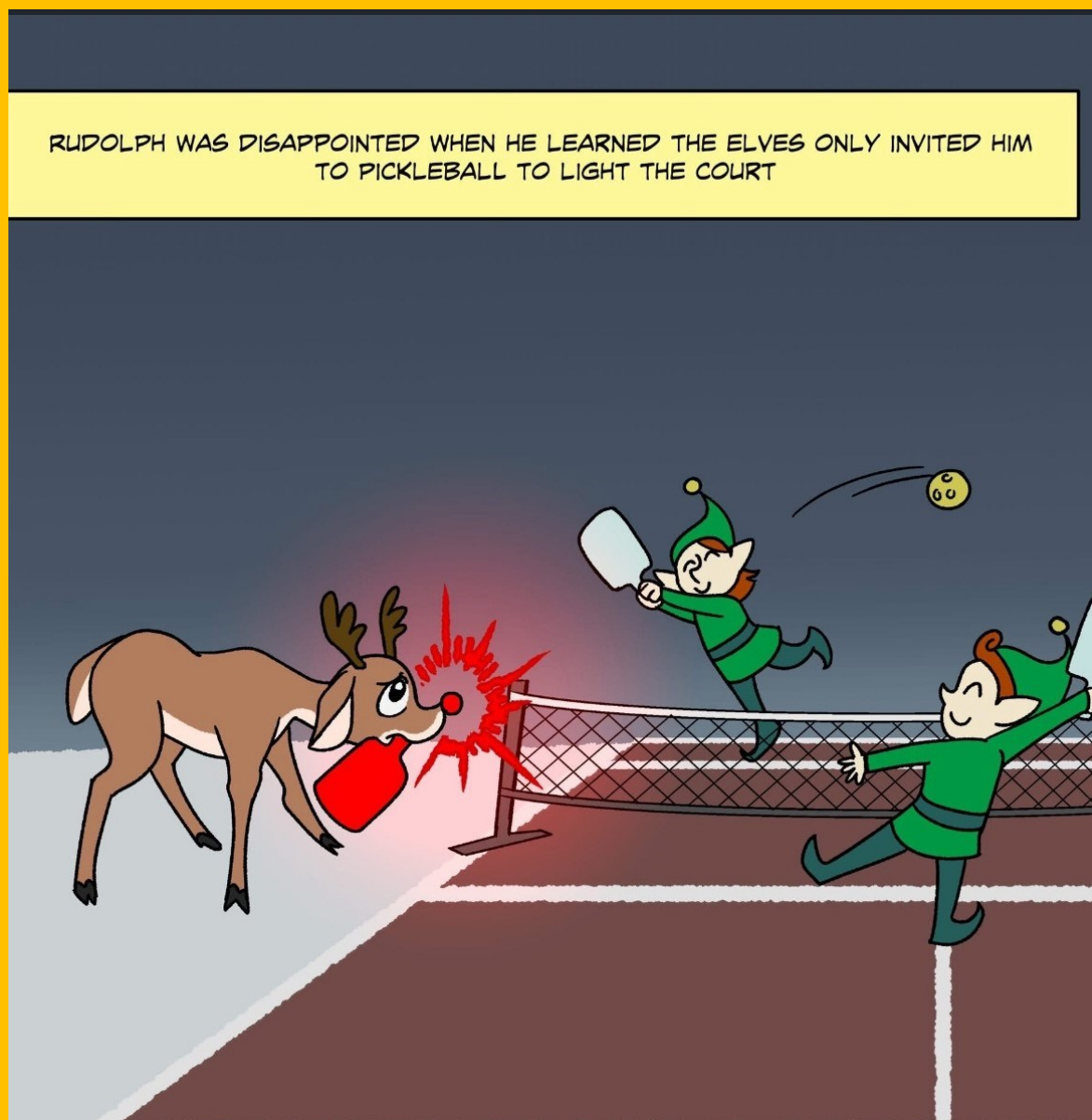
Santa Claus is Coming to Town
