

Keowee Key Pickleball Club 2024 Goals

- Increase KK Pickleball Club membership by 5% by fiscal year-end.
 - 400 members – July 1, 2023
 - 420 members – goal by July 1, 2024 (won't know final count until 8/31/2024)
- Continue safety knowledge and responsiveness for KKPb community while playing
 - Offer CPR training opportunities to Club members (2 sessions in 2024)
 - Provide ICE tags for all KKPb new members
- Continue to improve Interclub process and communications to ensure process is fair, equitable, and transparent to all members participating
 - Work closely with committee to ensure guidelines are inclusive and not exclusive to all KKPb Club members
- Improve communications with KKPb Club members and KKPOA community
 - Continue communications through 2 scheduled monthly newsletters with new format; short and concise focus of newsletters
 - Prepare monthly FRC E Blast to promote interest in pickleball and potential members
 - Create new player ambassador role to improve faster integration of new club member into PB community activities
- Refresh KKPb Club website layout for better utilization of space and to make it eye-appealing to users
- Finance
 - Implement an alignment process between membership and financials; is there a software package that would be more user friendly and link membership to financials?
- Player development
 - Larry (pro) to continue guidance in player development sessions
 - Drive increased participation in morning player development sessions
 - Offer training session quarterly for new/existing members on proper use of VAPTR, ball machine, pickleball etiquette, and SPOND guidelines and create videos to support.
- Social
 - Add new activities and events to drive increased member participation
 - Work closely with player development on tying in a social aspect to orientation sessions
- Competition
 - "Sell out" Classic Tournament (max number of people allowed to participate)
 - Develop succession plan for competitions – Is there a software package that is would be more user friendly?
