President's Corner

Greetings Pickle Nation!

This year has flown by and my term is coming to an end. It has been my great pleasure serving as your Board President and I've enjoyed getting to know the fantastic people associated with Pickleball! A huge thanks to my phenomenal Board members, who are a true gift to the community. Without their selfless giving of time and expertise, this club wouldn't be what it is today! Kudos Ann, Leslie, John, JJ, Scott, Joe, Joan, Jean, Randy and Mark. I commend you all for your giving spirits and professionalism!

Please see the below statement about new courts from your incoming President and Vice President, Ann Savoca and Leslie Walker:

With Keowee Key's 2020 vote package on the horizon, please be reminded that the next step toward construction of new Pickleball courts is approval of funds to complete a bid package for the courts and additional parking spaces for the FRC (FRC Phase 1). Funds are already available in the Major Projects Reserve to pay such fees. There is no assessment increase necessary to pay this expense. Community approval for FRC Phase 1 is required to pay for the cost of construction design documents. If the community votes 'yes', contractors will then develop firm bids for construction and a contractor will be selected. Once a contractor has been chosen and accurate project costs obtained, the KKPOA Board will call for a vote to proceed with FRC Phase 1. This vote would occur sometime in 2020. A 'yes' vote at this time does not commit us to invest in any of the projects currently under consideration nor does it commit us to any part of the FRC Master plan which anticipates further enhancements to the FRC campus in the coming years. If the construction design request is voted down, we will not have approval to develop a bid package for additional pickleball courts and will not get new courts in the foreseeable future. (Approval this November will simply allow the community to have a firm handle on the actual costs of the proposed project.)

The upcoming vote package will also include a request for community members to agree to an option to borrow up to an additional \$1M from our current bank at 3.89% (a better rate than we have for our existing loan). This funding will be used, ONLY if needed, for major Capital projects. These funds will not be 'tapped' and there will be no additional loan payments if the FRC Phase 1 project is not approved in 2020.
